Scenario 1: Consignment of garage waste

- They have a heap of oily rags, empty containers of oil, waste oil and a bin of waste paper from the office. They need to dispose of all the waste and have been told by a friend that it needs to be “consigned” as special (hazardous) waste.
- The friend puts them in touch with Simons Skips Services who tells them that he has organised Harry Henderson Hauliers to pick the waste up on Monday.
- Simons states that there will be some paperwork that needs filled in to accompany the movement of the waste.
