Progress to date


- Discovery 2018

Our prototypes


Two suppliers developed different prototypes




based on a three party movement




A waste holder can register, log on and upload/enter waste data




Three separate parties in a waste transaction can log on and each enter data to complete a transaction



A producer can find out the next destination and the likely end fate of their waste



A regulator can view and extract key information in a regulator dashboard






Next steps

Solving the first problem for users

Waste Tracking Problem 1 – where is waste going to?

Initial focus

Green list waste (GLW)

Key users

Carriers, brokers, dealers, regulators

Task

Advise the agency of intention to export GLW

Test in first iteration

- Guidance/routing for users
- Data ingestion methods for supplying data/info in advance of waste movement
- Reference IDs
- Data standard (fields/format)
- Upload of supporting info eg photo
- Online/automated data validation
- Notification/alerts
- View notification/alerts for a waste movement
- Need for paper docs/printing forms
- · Links to third party software
- Links to IWS online
- Reference/links to info from agency public registers
- Capture multiple carriers
